10. SHE SHED

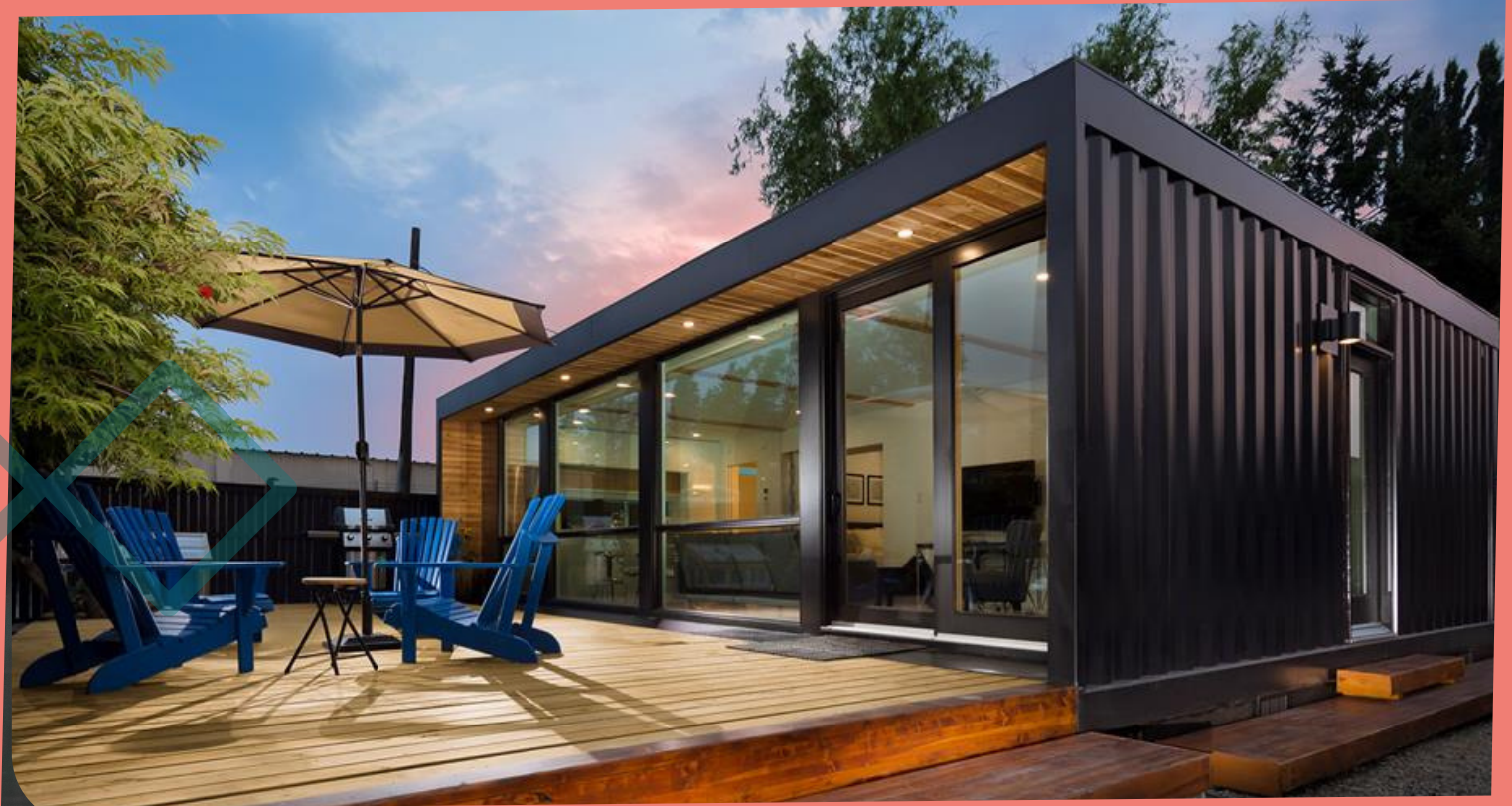

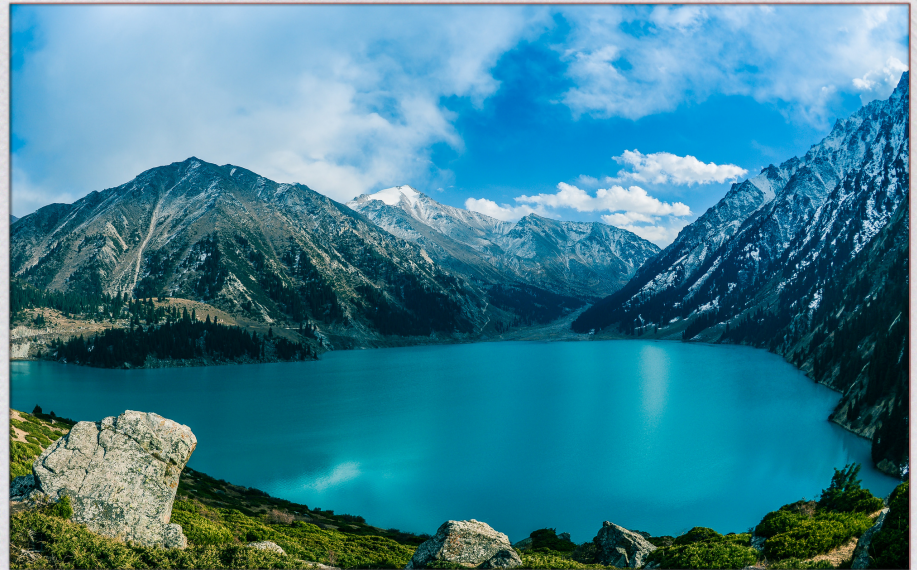
